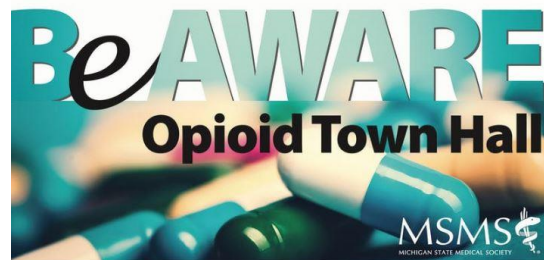
In-person and livestreamed audience is encouraged to submit case studies ahead of time and will be able to ask related questions during meeting.

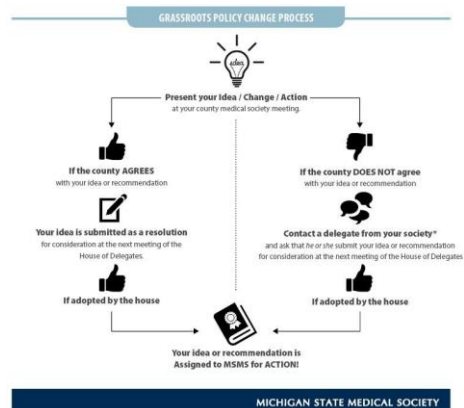
